
• Our staff will give you a call or SMS 1 working day before your day of admission to inform you of your Admission Time

Post Surgery/Procedure Care

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During recovery, we use the Numerical Rating Scale to score your pain(as illustrated below). Painrelief medications will be given to you to help reduce yourpain.



Common side effects post surgery:

- 1. Pain/bruising at the site of injections and intravenousdrips
- 2. Nausea and vomiting
- 3. Sore throat
- 4. Headache


Once you are fit for discharge, we will provide post-procedure advice as per your surgeon's instructions. Do continue to take the medication as prescribed by your surgeon. You can resume your dietary choices and take your routine medication after you leave our Day Surgery Centre, unless otherwise instructed. Your surgeon will discuss your procedure findings with you during the next appointment for review.

If you are undergoing **General Anesthesia/Sedation** for your surgery or procedure:



- Fast (no food and drinks) for at least 6 hours before your surgery or procedure.
- Do not apply makeup, nail polish or wear jewelry or contact lenses on day of surgery or procedure.
- **Do not drive** to StarMed Specialist Centre on day of surgery or procedure.
- Arrange for a relative or friend to accompany you home upon **discharge**, to ensure that you have a reliable caregiver at home.



Please take anti-hypertensive medication or other regular medications with sips of water on day of surgery or procedure. Please do not take diabetic and anti-coagulant medication on day of surgery or procedure. UNLESS ADVISED OTHERWISE BY DOCTOR / SURGEON

Bring your personal medications along that may be needed such as inhaler for asthma, etc. Bring any scan reports or blood test results that may be required by our





Before Your Surgery

Doctor / Surgeon.

- For your safety, a patient identification wrist band, which contains your name, NRIC, date of birth and drug allergy(if any), will be given on your admissionday.
- As part of our pre-surgery protocol, we will verify your consent for surgery and you may be asked several times to verify your name, identification number and date of birth. The doctor may mark the surgical site with a special pen to identify location.

Preparing for Surgery

If you are undergoing General or Regional Anesthesia, our anesthetist will verify your medical history and test results. He/she will oversee your anesthesia care throughout surgery.

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
